

Role - DISABILITY LIAISON OFFICER

The role of the Disability Liaison Officer is to focus on promoting inclusivity and ensures equal access and support for u3a members with disabilities or health related needs.

Support

The officer will communicate with new and existing members who indicate they require additional support or adjustments and discuss their needs.

Liaising

Will liaise closely with Group Coordinators and Leaders to ensure u3a groups are as accessible as possible by making reasonable adjustments, where possible.

General Meetings

They will ensure that General Meetings are equally accessible to disabled members including access to toilets and hearing loop systems

While Stubbington u3a strives to accommodate various needs, there may be limitations based on the level of care required by an individual.

The Disabled Liaison Officers role contributes to creating an inclusive and supportive environment for all u3a members.
